Historical Background of the College

Named after the patriotic king of The Nabha State His Highness Maharaja Ripudaman Singh, the college is one of the oldest colleges of the state. Maharaja Ripudaman Singh was born on 4th March, 1883 and was the only son of H.H. Maharaja Hira Singh. As a member of the Imperial legislative Council from 1906 to 1908 he served as the custodian of Sikh community's rights and formed an outline of Reformist Legislation. He represented Nabha State in the coronation ceremony of George V. He passed the Anand Marriage Act written by Bhai Kahan Singh of Nabha and it remained enforced from 1909-10-1949.

Maharaja Ripudaman was coronated as the king of Nabha State after the death of Maharaja Hira Singh in 1911. He brought many administrative reforms during his reign. Being a patriot he was exiled to Kodaikanal (Madras) by Britishers where he passed away at the age of 59.

Overview of the Institution

The college was established in 1946, and is affiliated to the Punjabi University, Patiala. The college has been accredited with B grade by NAAC. The main building of the college is surrounded by beautiful shady fruit trees, was especially built as the summer palace of the Maharaja. Also famous as "PUCCA BAGH" the main college building is a wonderful and rare monument of fine architecture. The patriotic Maharaja, H.H. Ripudaman Singh was exiled by the British Government. He donated his summer palace to start the college in order to provide higher education at low cost to the aspiring learners and less privileged section of the society. Thus, the college owes its existence to the benevolence and philanthropy of Maharaja Ripudaman Singh, one of the few Nationalist kings of the time. Upholding the noble traditions laid down by the founders, the institution surges ahead towards excellence. A vast majority of the students belong to the surrounding rural areas. The college has steadily grown, fulfilling its aims and goals. It offers undergraduate courses in Science, Commerce and Humanities and Postgraduate courses in English, Economics and Political Science. P.G.D.C.A., B.C.A. and M.Sc IT (Lateral Entry) are offered under Self Finance Scheme. Many old students of the college have made their mark in life, having reached top position in I.A.S., P.C.S., I.R.S., and P.P.S., in the Army and in Politics. Many renowned educationists and scholars have served the college as Principals. The teachers

of the college are highly qualified and competent. There are 10 Ph.D's and 11 M.Phil's among the faculty. Several Faculty members are pursuing Ph.D at present. The faculty members update their knowledge/skills by participating in Refresher and Orientation courses, seminars/workshops/conferences etc.

The Insignia of the college "Horse and Lion" are symbols of agility and power. The words inscribed under Insignia "Nuli Secundus" means "Second to None" and the college fulfills it.

Infrastructural Facilities:

The college has Administrative block, Science Block, Gymnasium, Commerce Block, Library building, Reading Room, Botanical Garden, Open-air theatre, Parking sheds, College Stadium and mini playground. There are 21 Departments, 35 classrooms, 08 laboratories, one conference room with Smart Board, and one Virtual classroom with E -podium in the college. The college has the credit of being one

with green cover having wide variety of shady fruit and ornamental trees and 10 beautiful parks. The Language Lab and library are fully computerised.

Admissions:

During academic year 2019-20, 2946 students got admission in various courses of the college out of which 1342 are girls and 1602 are boys and two are transgender students.

Examination Results:

The results of all classes of our college are enthusiastic in comparison to overall pass percentage of the University. In M.A. (English) Kajal (55352)143.00/6.50 cgpa, Radha Mittal(55353)143.00/6.50 cgpa, M.A. (Political Science) Amandeep Kaur (59650) 155.00/7.75cgpa, M.A. (Economics) Kuldeep Kaur(57551)190.00/7.60cgpa. Bhumika(23995) of B.com III topped with 80%. In B.Sc III (Medical) Navdeep Kaur with 81% got 1st position and Manu Goyal (12140)(Non-medical)came second with 80%. In B.A. III Sushmita (262301) came 1st with 76.8% and Mansi (262304)got 2nd position with 76%. In B.C.A. III Kavita Rani(12207) came 1st with 71% scoring 497 out of 700. In PGDCA Manpreet Kaur(3087)got 397 out of 500 with 79% and in M.Sc. IT (lateral entry) Gurnit Kaur scored77%.

Teaching Staff / Faculty:-

In this college there are 60 sanctioned teaching posts(Group A). On 08 Regular, 08 Part times, on 39 posts Guest Faculty are serving and 05 are vacant posts. In Group C there are 26 sanctioned posts, out of which 15 are filled and 11 are vacant. In Group D there are total 19 sanctioned posts, 10 are filled and 2 are vacant. Besides this there are 10 Self Financed posts and the Department's convener is Prof.Aami Bhalla.

Library:

Library is the brain of an educational institution. It's a treasure house of knowledge. There are over 54467 books in the library. There are 6 Journals, 17 magazines and 14 national and regional newspapers in Punjabi, Hindi and English. There are many rare manuscripts in the Refresh section of the

library. Book Bank Facility is also present to help SC/ST/BC//OBC/Handicapped/EWS, under which students can be issued books for the whole academic session.

E catalogue and internet facility is also available for faculty and students. Under UGC-INFLIBNET, New Delhi, N-list programmed, 31,39,209 e-book and more than 6094 e-Journals can be accessed by students and staff members. 30 students of B.Lib and M.Lib have been provided practical training in the college Library.

P.T.A (Parent Teachers Association):

The P.T.A is of great help to maintain proper interaction between the parents and the college authorities. The formal meetings are convened from time to time in which matters relating to college and students' welfare are discussed. RUSA Grant:

Under RUSA grant washrooms have been renovated at 5 sites and 4 sites new ones have been constructed under the able guidance of Principal Raj Kumari Madam. Dr. Balwinder Singh is the coordinator of RUSA. Out of the 4 newly constructed washrooms 3 are for girl students and are physically disabled friendly. To stop the inflow of rain water into the college campus the raised platform has been built at the Main Entrance Gate of the college. The wall of Mini Ground opposite the college stadium has been repaired and a new main gate has been installed. New building near Maharani Gurcharan Kaur Block had been constructed so now most of the bigger sections' classes could be taken indoors.

To meet the requirements of Practical Labs of Science, Geography, Home Science, Music and Physical Education new equipments have been purchased from Rs. 17 Lacs grant of RUSA.

Underground electrical wiring of the college campus was completed by PWD (Electric Wing) Patiala, from RUSA Infrastructural grant. Old washrooms of boys and Girls were also renovated

N.C.C:

Under the guidance of Lt. Dr. Balwinder Singh Waraich, 14th N.C.C. Battalion is doing commendable job. During the present year 40 cadets participated in Annual Training Camp at Aasra

College, Bhawanigarh, 6 Cadets at Advance Leadership camp, Bathinda, 6 cadets at Basic Leadership camp, 6 cadets at Training Camp, Meerut, 10 cadets at Pre-Republic Day camp, Ropar and 15 cadets at Army attachment camp, Sangrur. 40 N.C.C. cadets participated in Parade at sub-divisional level on 26th January and 15th August respectively. 35 cadets cleared the B certificate examination and 30 cadets passed C certificate examination. This year 6 cadets have been selected for Permanent Commission in Indian Army. 25 cadets also paid visit to Old Age Home at Rangla, Patiala.
